

Rainfall was heavy in the winter season, particularly during the months of June and September. Warmer temperatures followed throughout the mild spring, which allowed for a good development of the vines.

The summer, characterized by hot weather and little rainfall, favored the ripening of the grapes.

Tasting Notes

This dark ruby red wine is deep and opaque.

Ripe wild strawberry confiture, peppery chocolate, hints of fresh mint leaves, blackberries, tobacco, whole coffee beans and leather are concentrated in a very rich mineral nose.

This powerful wine reveals a silky, ample attack with a full bodied, massive and balanced structure. Dark chocolate, cypress, dried currants, and plums are persistent throughout the long-lasting finish.

This is a superb wine with great aging potential.

Cabernet Sauvignon: 70%

Carménère: 27%

Cabernet Franc: 3%
